TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Registration is capped at 40 participants; artists are accepted on a first come basis. Sign-up begins promptly on February 7, 2023, 12 PM by clicking on the live link at on the home page: www.livingstoncenter.org. Notification will begin on February 10th and payment will be taken at that time.

Check-in is Saturday, August 5, 2023, from 10am to 5pm at the Center located at 119 South Main Street in historic downtown Livingston, Montana. Our phone number is (406) 222-5222.

Each artist will provide their own canvases/boards to be stamped during check-in. Artists may return anytime during the week (during normal business hours) for additional canvas stamps.

An artist may paint any subject or location they choose as long as it is outdoors and within Park County, Montana during the event days.

New this year: Artists are permitted to submit two (2) pieces for judging, all combined not to exceed 1,200 sq. in. (i.e. if your canvas is 30" x 40" you are permitted ONLY one canvas).

Artists will provide their one paragraph biography and an image of their art (electronically) to the Center no later than May 1, 2023.

Sales commissions are 35% to the Livingston Center for Art and Culture and 65% to the artists for all sales made through the Center.
